Hosea 1-14

1. Which kingdom was the subject of Hosea's prophecy? Who was its king?
2. To what did God compare Israel's unfaithfulness?
3. What did God instruct the prophet to do?
4. What were the names of Hosea's children, and what did each name mean?
5. How were Hosea 1:10 and 2:23 fulfilled? (Rom. 9:24-27; 1 Peter 2:6-10)
6. How did Hosea 6:6 apply to the Pharisees? (Matt. 9:13; 12:7)

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7. What two events would make people say to the mountains, “Cover us” and to the hills, “Fall on us”? (Hos. 10:8; Luke 23:26-31)

8. To what historical event did Hosea 11:1 refer? To what later event would it also refer? (Matt. 2:15)

9. What were Admah and Zeboiim in Hosea 11:8? What happened to them? (Gen. 14:1-11; 19:23-29; Deut. 29:23)

10. In Hosea 13:14, God figuratively called upon Sheol and death to punish Israel for its sins. What application did Paul give these words in light of Jesus’ sacrifice in 1 Cor. 15:55?
