3. What did Micah foretell concerning Samaria? (Micah 1:6-7, 16)
4. Micah 1:10-15 uses several town names to convey God's punishment through wordplay. Select two town names from this text, find their meaning, and state how God used it in his condemnation.
5. Micah's career spanned three kings of Judah. Which one listened to him? (Jer. 26:17-19)
6. Which designation did Micah use for God's people 11 times? (Micah 1:5; 2:7)
7. Which group of people did Micah address specifically in chapter 3?
8. What did the prophecy in Micah 4:1-5 foretell? What other prophet made this same prophecy, and where is it recorded?

9. Where would Judah go into exile, and what would God do for them there?
(Micah 4:10)

10. What did Micah prophesy about Bethlehem? Find the Scripture which cites this prophecy and explains its fulfillment. (Micah 5:2)

11. Micah presented Israel's dispute with God as a court case in Micah 6:1-8.
 - a) What historical event proved that Israel's punishments were always just? Where was this event recorded in Scripture?

 - b) When Israel "took the stand," what did they imply? (v. 6-7)

 - c) Why weren't their offerings good enough? What did God require first?

12. What particularly evil kings did God name in his charges? (Micah 6:16)

13. What did Micah say about trust? (Micah 7:5-7)

14. How is God's forgiveness described in the closing verses of Micah? (7:18-20)
